Are YOU Ready for Back to School?

Top tips for a safe and healthy facility

The summer months are flying by and schools are reopening in just a few short weeks. This year, getting back to school means implementing a whole new set of standards to ensure that students and staff stay safe. Read on for tips to ensure your school is a healthy and safe learning environment.

Communicate local health guidelines

Navigating how to keep schools safe after reopening will require coordination between school staff, teachers AND students. Everyone entering the school must be familiar with the safety protocols before entering the building. This makes sending regular communications to families before the start of the school year, and continuing to send updates once school is in session, critically important. In school buildings, be sure to use posters in key areas to remind students and staff about physical distancing, wearing any required PPE and hand washing.

Revamp your cleaning protocol

Facility cleaning and disinfecting has never been more important for helping to prevent the spread of illness. This back to school season is a great opportunity to review and revamp your facility's cleaning protocol and provide refresher training to your cleaning teams. Things to consider include assessing cleaning frequency, tools, equipment and disinfectants. For example, making the switch from rags to colour-coded microfibre cleaning cloths can help improve cleaning effectiveness and reduce the risk of cross contamination.

Disinfect high touch surfaces


